- 1. What is your responsibility as a soldier in Christ's army?
 - a. At a minimum it is to train a replacement.
 - b. Responsibility has nothing to do with personal like or dislikes nor feelings.
 - c. Phil. 1:18-
 - d. Never quit, go AWOL, but transfers are ok.
 - e. Great things in the Bible are not done by great men or women, but people of persistence. Finish the work God has given them to do.
 - f. Like Jesus, you too can stop when you can say John 17:4.
- 2. What is best for the people or ministries you work with?
 - a. Satan is a liar and the father of lies.
- 3. Is the system able to run without you? If so, then may be time to move on.
- 4. What about your call to come here or to go there? Ex. 14:15
- 5. Is frustration a factor in your looking around?
 - a. How could your job description change to relieve the frustration?
 - b. Is there a specific place you are transferring to? IF not consider frustration as a potential invalid reason for the move.
 - c. Would adding an intern or competent administrative help allow you to use your gifts better?
 - d. List areas of frustration or discontent. Then see if they are personality issues rather than a call to move. Examples are: Distrust, broken promises, no support on budget, not appreciated, etc.
 - e. Are you familiar with the 7/8 rule in about 1/5th of any population? Basically what this is in opportunistic focused person who loves challenges. Once it is 7/8 finished that mindset shuts down. Can work on a term paper with ease until almost done, then cannot finish. Works in their relationships and job interest also. Basically a good employee becomes bored. Will intentionally do things to get fired as their mind set is not made for maintenance, but creating and conquering. They are high stress when a vision moves to a structure phase and becomes a program. Structure your job or theirs for growth, not maintenance.

 - a. Which will put more souls in heaven one day?
 - b. Which would require you to pour yourself out like a drink offering? Leave no blessings, opportunities to share Christ, spiritual gifts or any kind word behind when you do enter heaven?
